Shaw University's Department of Athletics Homecoming Tailgate Experience 2022 is here, and we are ready for another Epic Event! Listed below are the general tailgating guidelines:

- ❖ Tailgating is defined as setting up non-permanent items (i.e. tents or tables) to consume food and beverages prior to the football game.
- ❖ Cost of Tailgating: \$100 for each tailgating space and this **includes** ONE (1) football game ticket **and Tailgating pass**. All sales are final and non-refundable. Parking is not included.
- ❖ Parking is **NOT** included in your tailgating fee. All attendees are required to pay the facility parking fee which is \$15 per vehicle.
- ❖ All patrons must purchase game day ticket which allows entrance to the tailgating area AND general admission access into the football game.
- ❖ Game Day tickets are \$30.00 and can be purchased at Tailgating area or Stadium ticket booth.
- ❖ Tailgating areas are reserved for fans, recognized student organizations and Alumni groups.
- ❖ Use of motorized vehicles, including four-wheelers, golf carts, mules, gators, scooters, motorized skateboards, etc., are prohibited.
- ❖ Vehicles are prohibited from parking within the tailgating area. Due to the size of the tailgating spaces vehicles must be parked in the facility's designated parking area.
- ❖ Patrons are **NOT** allowed to tailgate in the parking area.
- ❖ Pets are not allowed in tailgating sites, inside Durham County Memorial Stadium, or parking lot at any time. Furthermore, animals shall not be left unattended in personal vehicles or secured to property.
